Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Academy of Allied Health and Science, as well as the NJ Department of Education, require that parents be informed of all standardized testing dates at the beginning of the school year. The first test will be the PSAT, which is given to all 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students to prepare them for the SAT. PARCC testing is for all students currently enrolled in English 1, English 2, English 3, Geometry, Algebra I, and Algebra II. **The NJ Student Learning Assessment-Science will be administered to all junior students; it will consist of Earth Science, Life Science, and Physical Science. This year, the NJSLA-S will be a FIELD TEST.** AP testing is administered to all 12th grade students enrolled in AP Calculus. Dual enrollment testing (i.e. Rutgers' testing) information will be available at the end of each semester.


